Things to Know

1. Any recycling, garbage, or rubbish must be placed at the curb for collection no earlier than 6 p.m. on the evening before collection and no later than 5:30 a.m. on the day of the collection.
2. Do not put any recyclables in plastic or brown paper bags.
3. In the event of heavy snow, flooding, or extreme weather conditions, your recyclables and garbage will be collected on your next designated recycling or garbage day.

White Goods

As of January 1, 1999, Hackensack residents must purchase a sticker for the collection of white good items. The cost of the sticker is \$10.00 per item. You can purchase these stickers at the D.P.W. located at 120 East Broadway. Make your check or money order payable to the City of Hackensack. No cash will be accepted. Anyone placing white goods at the curb without a sticker will receive a summons. All residents are responsible for what is placed at the curb in front of their homes. HUMAN SERVICE DEPARTMENT

The City of Hackensack's Human Services Department operates state-funded programs to assist single individuals with no dependent children who are unemployed, homeless, or mentally or physically disabled. The department also addresses many social services issues throughout the city.

Our department is on call 24/7 for emergencies during non-working hours and can be contacted through the Hackensack Police Department at 201-646-7777.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

The Hackensack Police Department provides a multitude of services regarding enforcement, safety, and assistance to the community. The department is comprised of 112 officers and 19 civilian employees. The department also employs 43 school crossing guards and oversees 6 auxiliary police officers, who assist with traffic control duties. The Hackensack Police Department is divided into seven divisions for the purpose of addressing law enforcement concerns.

The divisions are as follows: Patrol Division, Detective Division, Narcotics Division, Youth Division, Traffic Division, Bureau of Criminal Identification, and the Community Policing Unit.

Also, the department administers numerous programs that work in partnership with the community. Among them are the following: Neighborhood Block Watch, Operation Identification, Crime Stoppers, Safe Housing Program, Crime Deterrent, and the H-COPS Program.

MUNICIPAL COURT

FIRE DEPARTMENT

The Hackensack Fire Department responds to fire alarms, motor vehicle accidents, rescue calls, hazardous materials incidents, first-responders medical calls, and all other types of emergencies. The department operates four Engine Companies, one Truck Company and one Rescue Company under the command of a Deputy Chief 24 hours a day, seven days a week. All companies carry automatic defibrillators for cardiac arrest victims.

The department also operates a special operations unit that can be called for confined-space rescue, high-angle rescue, trench rescue, and building collapse. All firefighters are trained and equipped to respond to incidents involving weapons of mass destruction incidents. Other operations include emergency management, a fire prevention bureau, and an apparatus repair shop. The department also provides fire safety education for citizens and for the schools along with participation in the Police Department's annual Youth Academy.

TAX COLLECTOR'S OFFICE

Our office is open from 9:00 – 4:00. We offer extended hours one evening during each tax quarter. Please call or check the Tax Collector's page on our website for those dates. We also have a drive-thru tax payment drop box for checks only, open 24/7 located in the driveway between the City Hall and the Police Department, exiting State Street. BUILDING & LAND USE DEPARTMENT

This department handles all commercial and residential permit applications and inspections in the city. The Department is now located at 410 E. Railroad Avenue, off Passaic Street. Hours are from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM. Ample parking is available. The Department can be reached at 201-646-3920 and forms can be found at www.hackensack.org.

RECYCLING AND SANITATION

The City of Hackensack recycles commingled glass, tin, aluminum, and plastic placed in an open container (No Plastic Bags); newspaper tied in bundles; corrugated cardboard crushed and tied in bundles; and junk mail in an open container or tied in a bundle. Junk mail includes all paper products, cereal boxes, magazines, phone books, soft cover books and hard cover books with covers removed. Residents are required to pay \$10 (Check or Money Order) for the collection of each white good item. A white good is a metal object such as appliances, desks, shelving, etc. To arrange for a white good collection, please come to the recycling office located on the second floor of the Department of Public Works complex at 120 East Broadway or send a check or money order to City of Hackensack Sanitation Department, 65 Central Ave., Hackensack, NJ 07601. You will receive a sticker to be placed on the item and a date for collection.

Residential recycling is collected once a week on your current garbage day. Batteries, Electronic Waste (small appliances, TV's, computers etc.), and fluorescent bulbs are no longer collected with rubbish but can be dropped off at the DPW Monday through Friday 8am — 4pm and Saturdays 7am — Noon.
