



Construction of upgrades and improvements to the City of Hackensack’s storm and sanitary sewers under City of Hackensack - Various Sanitary Sewer Improvements and Repairs; Contract 1: Sewer Infrastructure Improvements and Contract 2: Stormwater Pump Station Emergency Generator (NJWB No. S340923-22) in Hackensack, NJ in the amount of approximately \$1.23M were financed by the New Jersey Water Bank (NJWB). The NJWB is a State Revolving Fund program jointly administered by the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the New Jersey Infrastructure Bank (Infrastructure Bank) and uses a combination of funds provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency, the DEP, and the Infrastructure Bank to provide very low interest loans to borrowers for environmental infrastructure projects.

These projects will provide water quality benefits by completing sewer repairs mitigating leakage from collapsed pipes and loose joints from sanitary sewer as well as the installation of an emergency generator at the East Kennedy Pump Station. In addressing infiltration and inflow into the system will improve water quality for residents and businesses in City of Hackensack combined sewer service area.
