ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Under direction of the Construction Official, reviews plans and performs electrical inspection work to enforce the State Uniform Construction Code, the electrical subcode, and regulations adopted pursuant to the Uniform Construction Code Act; does other related work.

- Must be able to inspect and evaluate electrical work on construction projects.
- Must be able to inspect and or/ supervise inspection of electrical installations in existing buildings for conformance with the minimum safety standards incorporated in the regulations of the Uniform Code and relevant laws within the jurisdiction.
- May establish inspection schedules for subordinates.
- Prepare reports and maintain records and files.
- May perform other similar duties as needed.

Appointees will be required to possess a valid New Jersey driver's license.

Must have a valid license as an Electrical Inspector of the appropriate level, and as an Electrical Subcode Official from NJ Department of Community Affairs (HHS license required).
