This letter serves to inform you that the City has adopted a new ordinance authorizing residential parking stickers for the hours of 2:00 AM to 6:00 AM on the streets listed below. The ordinance was formally adopted at the January 6, 2026, Council Meeting held at City Hall, and this notice is being provided to advise residents of the newly approved requirements.

Berry Street	from DeWolf Place to Union Street
James Street	Entire Length
Berdan Place	Entire Length
Clay Street	from Third Street to Railroad Ave (West)
High Street,	entire length
Central Avenue	from Railroad Ave (West) to First Street
Railroad Ave (West)	from Passaic Street to Central Avenue
First Street	from Passaic Street to Central Avenue
Second Street	from Passaic Street to Central Avenue
Third Street,	entire length
Haynes Place,	entire length
DeWolf Place,	entire length
Railroad Place,	entire length

There is no longer a \$5 fee for a Resident Parking sticker. No more than one vehicle per licensed driver shall be issued a sticker. Your license & registration **must** match your home address. Resident parking stickers may be obtained at the Hackensack Police Department, located at 225 State Street. Applications are also available on the City's website at <https://www.hackensack.org/traffic-bureau/> under the "Files and Links" section, titled "Residential Parking Applications."

As the ordinance has been adopted and appropriate signage installed, any vehicle that does not properly display a resident parking sticker will be subject to ticketing and/or towing.
