BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENTS AND SUMMARIES

The bond ordinance 08-2026, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the City of Hackensack, in the County of Bergen, State of New Jersey on May 26, 2026 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours, at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: Bond Ordinance Providing An Appropriation Of \$630,000, Providing For The Construction of a Replacement Elevator For The Johnson Public Library In And For The City of Hackensack, In The County Of Bergen, New Jersey And Authorizing The Issuance Of \$598,500 Bonds Or Notes Of The City For Financing Part Of The Appropriation.

Purpose(s): For the construction of a replacement elevator for the Johnson Public Library located at 274 Main Street in Hackensack, including all work and materials necessary therefore or incidental thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with the plans and specifications thereon on file in the Office of the Clerk.

Appropriation: \$630,000

Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$598,500

Grants (if any) Appropriated: \$99,000 expected to be received as a Community
Development Block Grant.

Section 20 Costs: \$60,000

Useful Life: 15 years
